EAGLES ADVENTURE CAMP 2025 INFORMATION

<u>CAMP DATES</u> – Camp begins *Monday*, *June* 9th and ends on *Friday*, *August* 1^{st.} Eagles Adventure camp will be closed the week of **June** 23rd through **June** 27th, if you are in need of childcare for the week, let us encourage you to register with Patria for VBS.

<u>CAMP HOURS</u> – Camp will begin at 8:00am and will dismiss at 4:00pm. Students can be checked in at 7:45am through the elementary school office without being charged an extended care fee.

EXTENDED CARE – Extended morning care opens at 6:30 am and closes at 7:45am. Afternoon extended care opens at 4:15pm and closes at 6:00pm. Students picked up after 6:00pm will be charged at a rate of \$5.00 per minute, per student. Students must be checked – in and out by a parent or an authorized person (authorized pick- up, must present identification at check-out), in order to help us maintain a high level of security. (Payments are to be made as often as necessary to keep account current. A late fee of \$20 will be charged to any account which is 10 days past due)

<u>STUDENT DROP-OFF</u> – Students should be walked in by a parent or other authorized person and signed in through the Elementary School Office. Parents or authorized persons dropping off students are encouraged to park in the North parking lot near the Elementary School Office. Parents dropping students off and picking students up will enter and exit the campus from the west end of the campus through the ALFC Administration Building driveway off of Red Oak or the northeast gate near the hospital. <u>Parents are not permitted to park in front of the Patria Administration Building.</u>

<u>STUDENT PICK-UP</u> – Students will be checked – out from the elementary office only. Upon return from field trips please allow for all students to exit the bus and return to the campus accordingly. All students are accounted for prior to exiting the bus and once they arrive back to campus allowing for them to return safely will ensure a safe and effective dismissal.

<u>EMERGENCY / PICK-UP / EMAIL INFORMATION</u> – Each family should go into **Powerschool** and complete your home/mailing address, email address for both parents, home and cell phone numbers for parents, as well as all the emergency contact information in case of an emergency. Please try to include as many emergency contacts as possible.

<u>COMMUNICATIONS</u> - UCA will be using **ParentSquare** to communicate with you this summer camp. Please make sure you check your inbox for any daily updates, camper communications, and/or schedule adjustments.

<u>DAILY CAMP ATTIRE</u> – Please take time to carefully review the required camp attire document, as it will be strictly enforced beginning the first day of camp. Parents are expected to make sure that their children are dressed in accordance with the camp dress code and not deviate from it. Students who are not properly dressed will not be admitted to class and must be brought camp-approved attire from home or picked up by a parent. Subsequent dress code violations will result in further consequences.

HOT LUNCH– Progressive Catering for Schools is our campus food provider. Lunch meals will be available to be PRE-ORDERED online through our new lunch ordering system, **Meal Magic**. Lunch ordering procedures will be posted via **ParentSquare**. The price for lunch is \$6.25 per day. If your child needs an emergency lunch it will be \$8.00 and you will be billed to your child's account.

<u>WATER DAYS-</u> Girls are only allowed to wear one piece bathing suits, no two-piece suits and no tankini suites. All girls are required to wear shorts over their bathing suites. Boys are required to wear a t-shirt/rash guard with their trunks. Water shoes must be worn at all times, students who do not have extra shoes will not be allowed to participate. For safety reasons absolutely no bare feet or flip flops will be allowed. Parents should apply sunscreen on their camper before checking them in, camper may re-apply on self only for health precautions camper may not share. All personal items should be labeled with your child's first and last name including: personal bags, towels, under clothes, socks waterguns etc;

<u>CAMP SUPPLIES</u> – Please make sure your child comes prepared each day of camp with their choice of snacks for the day, a hydro flask filled with water, and a beach towel with their permanently name on it. Additional supplies will be required based on camp activities; parents will be notified in advance.

PERSONAL ITEMS – Such as dolls, stuffed animals, toys, personal sports equipment, puzzles, trading cards (ex: Pokemon cards) crayons, DVD's, or markers etc; may not be brought to camp. In the event a child brings personal items from home it will be held in the office until end of day and will be returned to the parent / guardian upon pickup. Personal items will only be allowed on designated, "Show & Tell" days.

<u>NO ELCTRONIC DEVICES</u> - Students are not allowed to bring iPad, iPod, iPhone, electronic watches, cellphones, tablets, laptops or gaming devices to camp. If a device is brought from home it will be held in the office until end of day and will be returned to the parent / guardian upon pick-up.

<u>MEDICATION</u> – All medication including over the counter medication, requires a Doctors Authorization Form to administer. Authorization forms to administer medication on campus and any additional forms are available in the elementary office.
